1. Complainant and her mother appeared in person with their
counsel.

2. During the course of arguments, it was agreed that the petitioner shall pay ₹20 lacs to the complainant without prejudice and subject to future adjustment (if any). On this, complainant has no objection to the grant of bail to the petitioner.

3. It is further agreed that ₹5 lacs deposited by the petitioner in compliance of the order dated 08.08.2014 shall be released to the complainant. Remaining amount of ₹15 lacs shall be paid to the complainant by way of demand draft within four months from today.

4. Accordingly, petitioner is admitted to anticipatory bail in case FIR No.659/2014 registered under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at PS Malviya Nagar and FIR No.577/2013 registered under Sections 420/466/471/494 IPC at PS Malviya Nagar, and in the event of arrest, he be released on furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety each in the like amount to the satisfaction of the SHO / Investigating officer. He shall, however, join the investigation as and when required. The petitioner shall pay ₹20 lacs to the complainant without prejudice and subject to future adjustment (if any). ₹5 lacs deposited by him in this Court shall be released to the complainant immediately. Remaining amount of ₹15 lacs shall be paid to the complainant by way of demand draft within four months from today. In case of non-compliance, the complainant / State shall be at liberty to approach this Court.

5. The bail applications stand disposed of. Pending applications also stand disposed of.
